Entwicklung der globalen Weizenexporte und Anteil Russlands und der Ukraine

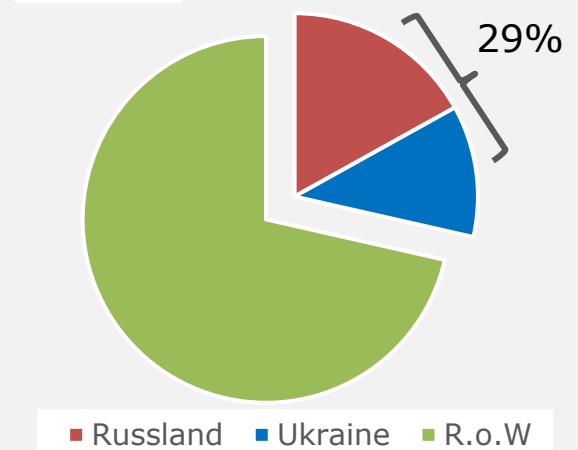
Globale Weizenexporte 2010/11 - 2021/22

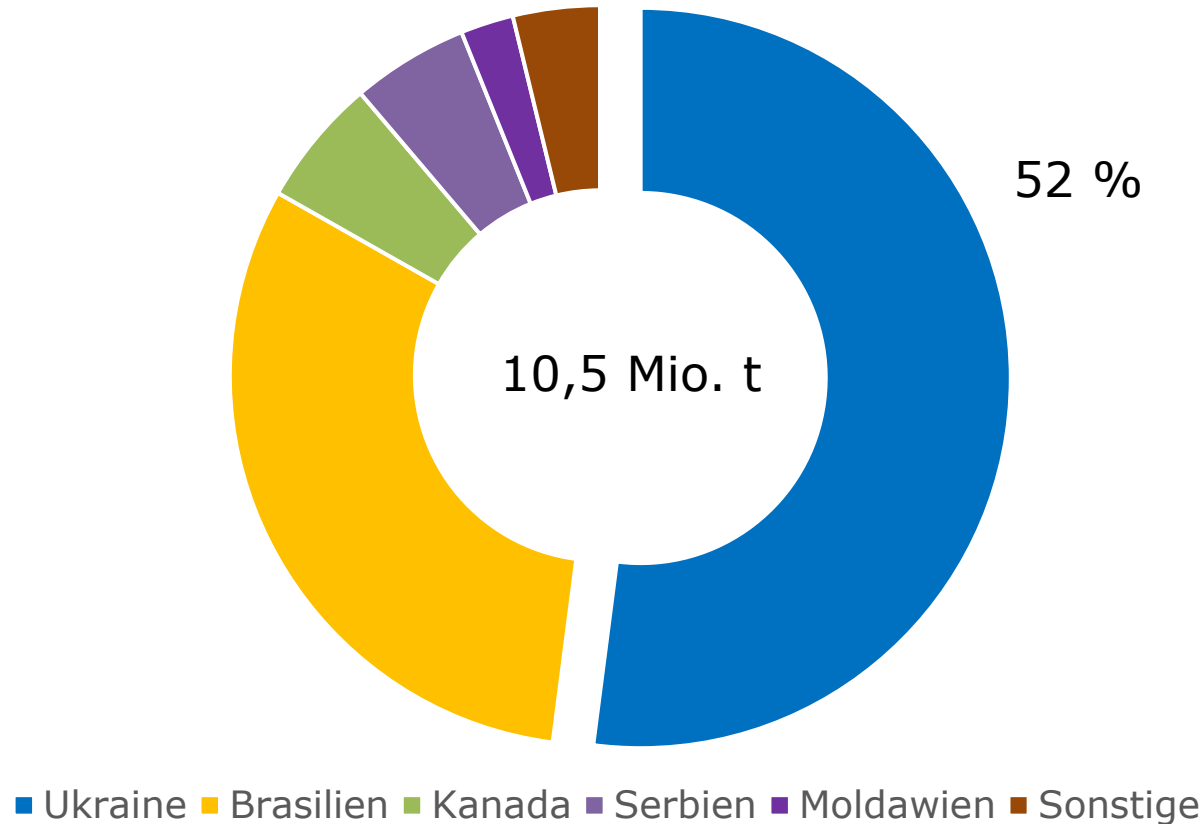

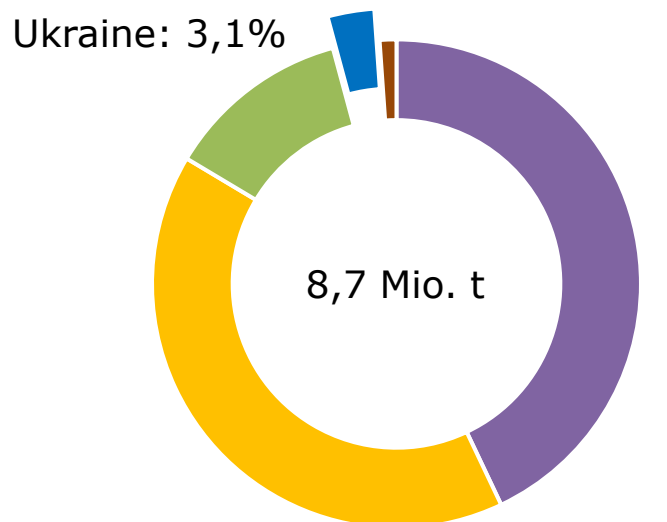
EU Mais-Importe 2021/22

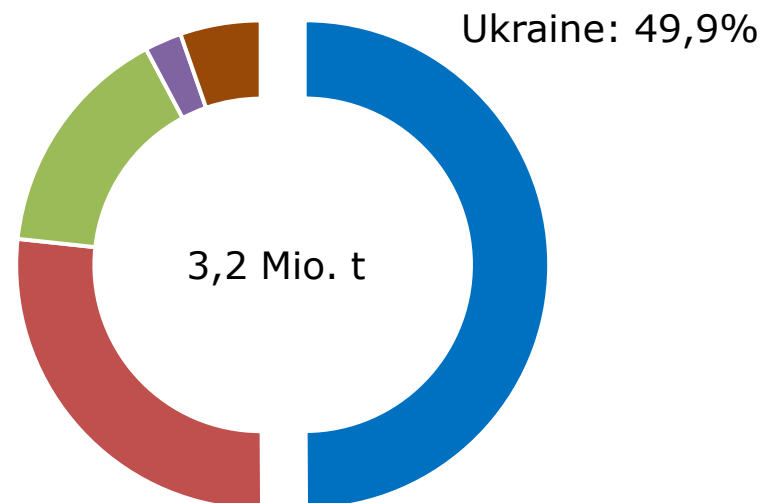

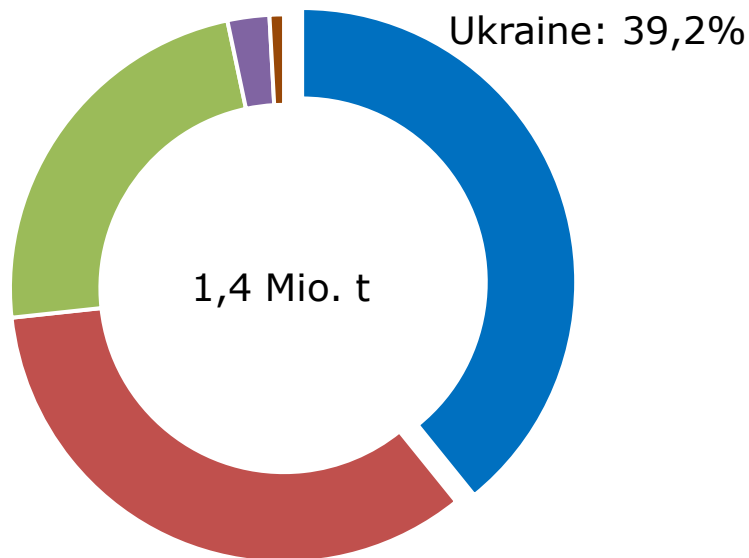

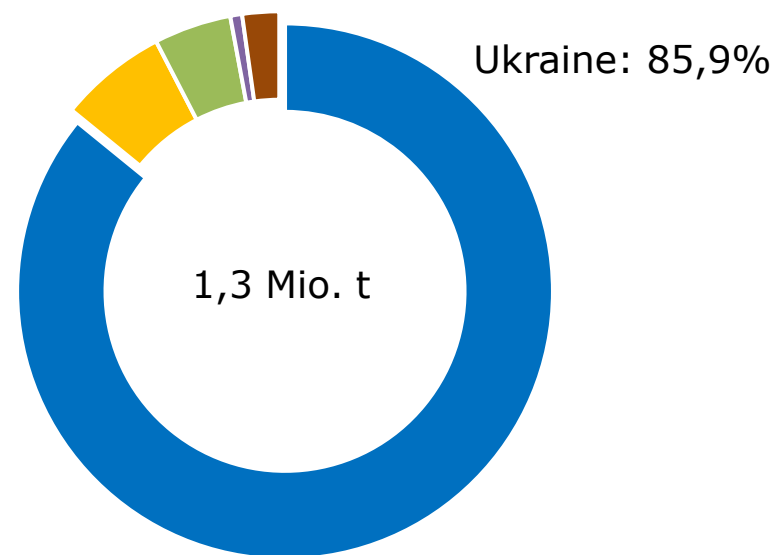

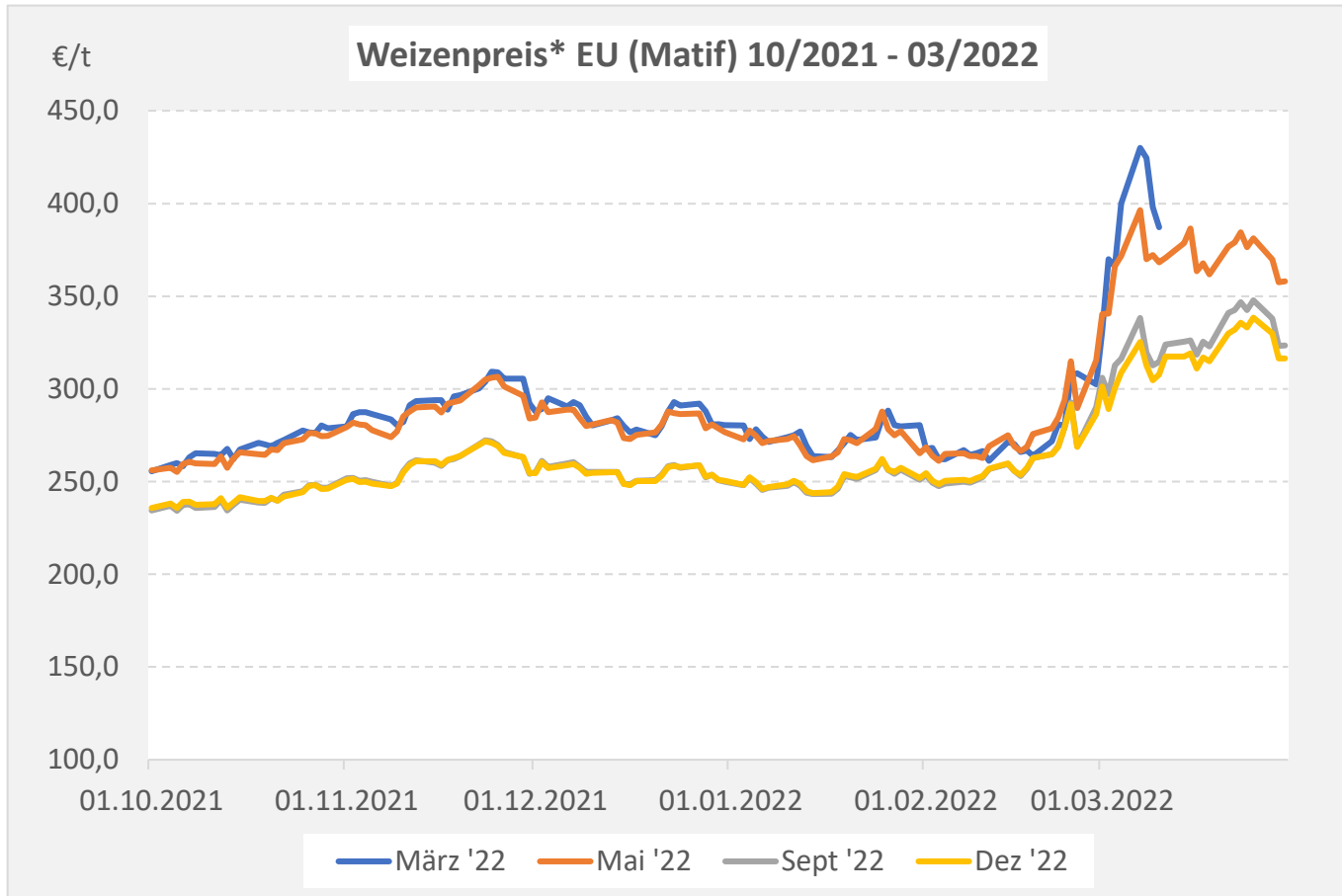

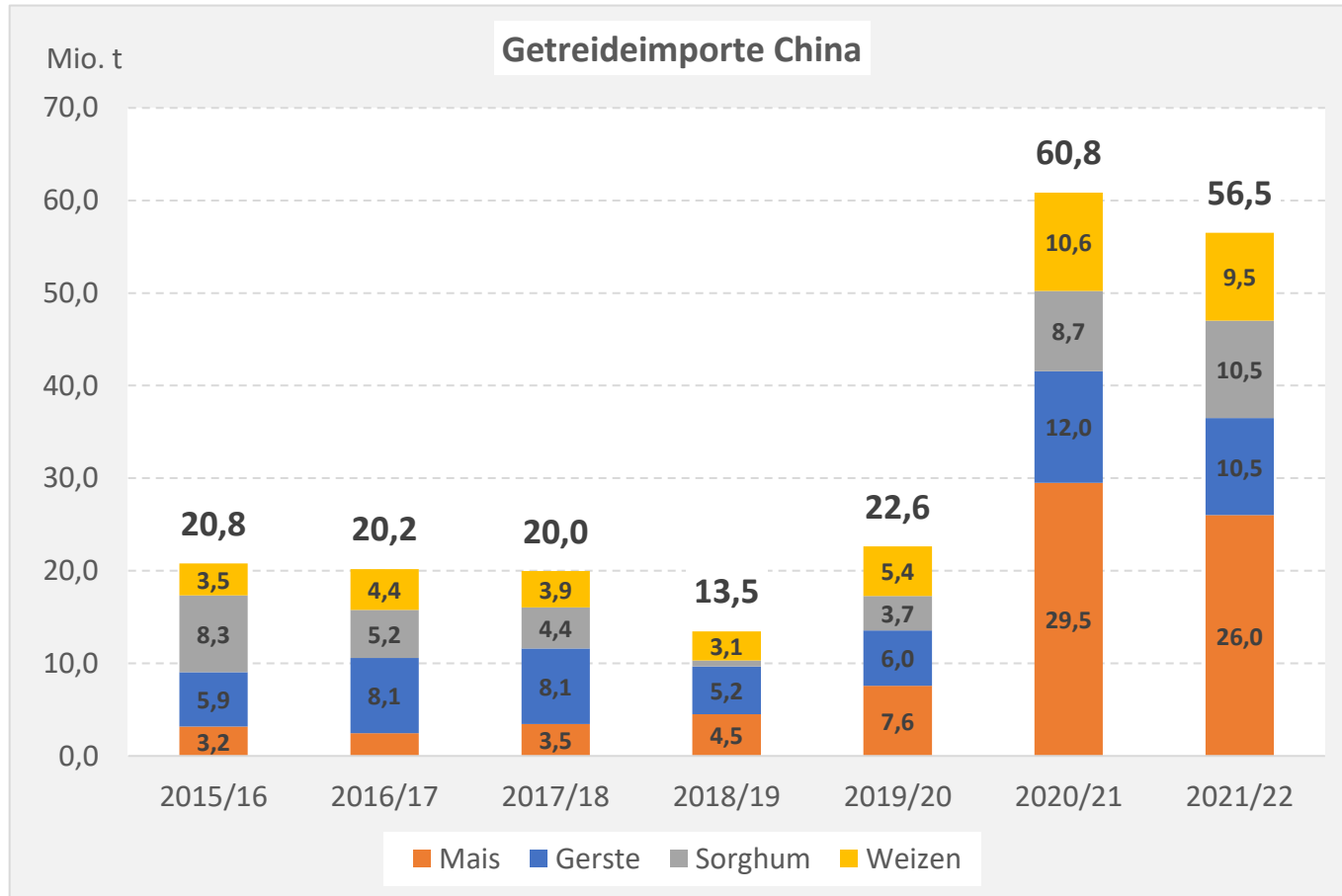

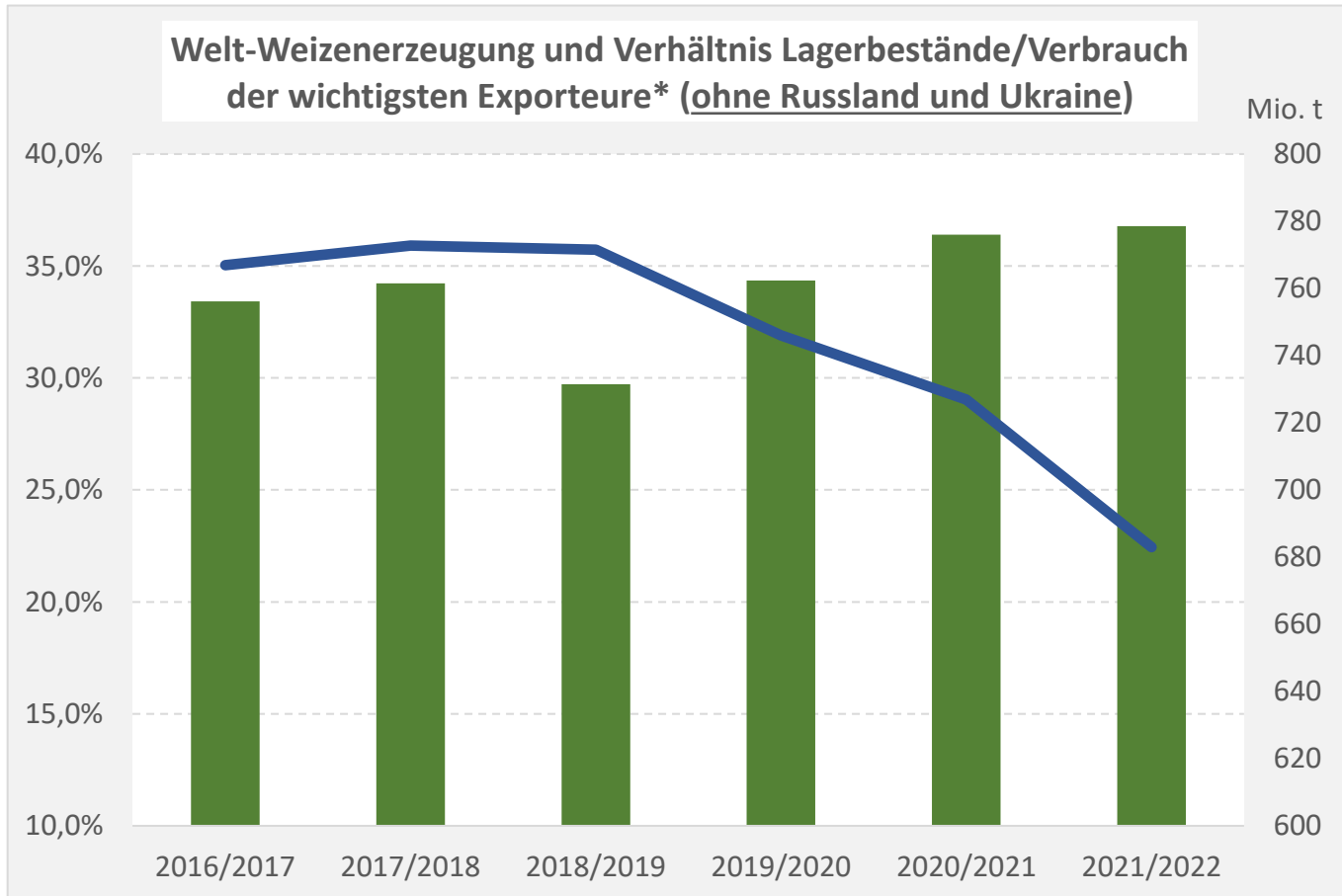
